The joint regular meeting of the Boards of Directors of The Lakes Metropolitan District Nos. 1, 3-4 (referred to hereafter as "Boards") were convened on Tuesday, October 17, 2023 at 9:30 a.m., via teleconference. The meeting was open to the public.

**CALL TO ORDER** 

Director Richardson noted that a quorum of the Boards were present and called the Joint Regular Meeting of the Boards of Directors to order. Director Richardson designated Director Volling as the chairperson of the meeting.

DISCLOSURE OF POTENTIAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST & ESTABLISH QUORUM Director Volling noted that disclosures of potential conflict of interest statements for each of the Directors were filed with the Secretary of State by the District General Counsel, White Bear Ankele Tanaka & Waldron, P.C., seventy-two hours in advance of the meeting. Attorney Hartung requested that the Directors consider whether they had any additional conflicts of interest to disclose. 144th Avenue and Chambers Trail Paving Public Improvement Pricing and Status: At the June 20, 2023 BOD meeting, it was determined that District No. 4 would provide monthly updates to District No. 3 at the monthly BOD meetings to satisfy the status report requirements in the Assignment of and Second Amendment to Capital Improvements Pledge Agreement dated November 9, 2022. The monthly update from District No. 4 was the curb, gutters, and sidewalks along 144th are complete. United Power is still working to be able to remove the power poles that are in the way of construction. Paving work has started on 144th.

Phase 1 has received the top lift of paving with the exception of Chambers Road. Xcel Energy contractors are expected on-site this week of October 17<sup>th</sup>.
